















## **Answers to last month's trivia:**

What Chinese national holiday typically occurs during the month of September? **The Moon Festival; considered one of the most important Chinese Festivals and takes place on the 15<sup>th</sup> of October, in celebration of the moon and the Fall Harvest?**

**What is the Fall Equinox? The day in which the Sun is in line with the Equator, and both night and day are exactly 12 hours each.**
